Not suited for varnished surfaces.

APPLICATION DETAILS:

Application method: Brush Dipping Rag wiping

Thinner (max. vol.): Do not dilute

Indicated film thickness: Not relevant (see REMARKS overleaf)

Recoat interval, min: When dry

SURFACE Untreated wood:

PREPARATION: Remove any oil, grease etc. with BLAKES SURFACE CLEANER, hose down with clean fresh

water. Clean the surface with BLAKES TEAK CLEANER. Rough surfaces may possibly be

abraded with paper 180-220, remove dust.

Previously treated wood:

Remove any oil, grease, etc. with BLAKES SURFACE CLEANER. Hose down the surface with

clean fresh water, allow to dry.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS:

The surface must be completely clean and dry. Apply only in dry weather and at temperatures above 5°C/41°F. In confined spaces provide adequate ventilation during application and drying.

SUBSEQUENT

COAT:

None.

REMARKS: Apply BLAKES TEAK OIL abundantly. Allow the wood to absorb the sealer for some minutes

before any surplus is removed with clean rags to avoid a glossy film after drying. It is possible to

abrade in the still wet sealer with paper 180-220, abrading parallel to grain. Spreading rate depends on the structure and absorption of the wood.

Maintenance is carried out by BLAKES TEAK OIL, which is applied in a thin coat followed by

removal of any surplus by clean rags.

To avoid staining remove promptly any Teak Oil splashed onto gelcoat or paint coating. Beware that over application of BLAKES TEAK OIL could result in making the surface slippery, which

could be dangerous on decks.

As auto ignition of rags impregnated with BLAKES TEAK OIL is possible, they should be safely

disposed after use.
