## 2. BLAKES UNDERWATER PRIMER

APPLICATION Remove all contaminants with BLAKES SURFACE CLEANER followed by fresh water rinsing.

CONDITIONS: Remove loose paint and foreign matters.

Allow the substrate to dry, sand bare spots, and remove dust completely.

SURFACE The surface must be completely clean and dry. The temperature of the surface should be

above the dew point to avoid condensation. In confined spaces provide adequate ventilation

during application and drying.

PRECEDING COAT: BLAKES GELPROTECT SFE200, BLAKES EPOXY PRIMER UNDERCOAT, BLAKES

KEEL PRIME or according to specification

SUBSEQUENT

PREPARATION:

COAT: BLAKES TIGER XTRA, BLAKES CRUISING PERFORMER, BLAKES OCEAN PERFORMER,

BLAKES HARD RACING, BLAKES BROADS, or according to specification.

REMARKS: The cans should be opened with care as there may be risk of overpressure.

Before overcoating after exposure in contaminated environment clean surface thoroughly by high

pressure fresh water hosing or by hosing down with fresh water and scrubbing with a stiff brush

and allow to dry.
